

Who are Trinity College?

Trinity College London is one of the two principal validating bodies for training programmes in the UK and internationally for teachers of English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL.) Trinity's TESOL qualifications are among the most widely recognised external qualifications in this field. Trinity does not run training programmes. They validate course providers and they quality assure every course they run through moderation and assess the performance of every candidate before issuing them with their Trinity Certificate. They work closely with first class training providers in the UK and around the world who meet Trinity's stringent requirements, and inject their own expertise and distinctive skills into the programme leading to the Certificate.

What is the validity of a Trinity CertTESOL ?

The Trinity Certificate (the 'CertTESOL' for short) is accepted by employers in the UK and worldwide, including the British Council, as a rigorous qualification. The CertTESOL is accredited at Level 4 by the QCA (Qualifications and Curriculum Authority) in the National Qualifications Framework.

The CertTESOL programme run by Byron Language Development meets the strict guidelines laid down by Trinity College, London. In accordance with their validation requirements, every course we run is moderated by Trinity College. The role of the Trinity moderator is to evaluate both the quality of the course and that of the trainees' work and to assess individual trainees.
